<p>Flashcards Create flashcards for all the words from one of the lists (Adjectives, Geography, etc...) and study with them for at least 10 min</p> <p><i>Get it signed by a teacher, parent, or guardian when completed:</i></p> <hr/>	<p>Write: Write a story, paragraph, dialogue using at least 15 of the new vocabulary words</p> <p>OR Write at least 12 sentences using minimum of 15 new vocabulary words from the list</p>	<p>Play Bingo, Pictionary, Charades: With group of no more than 4, decide what vocabulary you want to use and any other minor rules needed. Have each person take turns being the caller. Play as many rounds as you have group members (or until you have used 20 words)</p>
<p>Mind Map: Draw a mind map of ALL the vocabulary showing how words relate to each other- the more graphic you make your mind map the easier it will be for you to remember the words</p>	<p>Create your own Activity!
